

MCHS 2024 Candidates for Graduation

Important Dates:

- **Graduation Meeting:**
- **Senior Week: May 20-24th**
- **Senior Awards Ceremony: May 22, 8:30am, Auditorium**
 - Dress code: Business attire
 - NO sneakers, flip-flops, jeans, shorts or you will be sent back to class!
 - If you plan to attend, meet in the Gym at **8:00am**
- **Graduation Rehearsal: June 4th, 5:30-7pm, Bojangles Coliseum**
 - 2700 E Independence Blvd, Charlotte, NC 28205
 - Graduates (only) need to arrive **no later than 5pm**
 - **If you do not participate in rehearsal, you do not walk at graduation**
- **Graduation: June 10th, 7:00pm, Bojangles Coliseum**
 - 2700 E Independence Blvd, Charlotte, NC 28205
 - Graduates need to be dressed in full regalia (cap, gown & tassel)
 - **Graduates need to arrive by 6:00pm** in front of the coliseum

Things to do before Graduation:

- Stay on track. Double-check your grades, missing assignments, attendance, GPA, etc. in each course.
- **All Edgenuity courses must be completed by May 31st.** Credit recovery and initial course credit. The district will shut down courses after 11:59pm on May 31st. Complete CMS Senior Exit Survey in Naviance by **June 4th**
- Upload all scholarships and documentation in Naviance by **May 10th**
- Make sure you have your cap and gown - Southern Recognition - Contact Rob Kass if needed. (407-209-8112) (rob.kass@southernrecognition.com)
- Students should **not** decorate their regalia (if altered, you will not be allowed to walk). **Only CMS-approved regalia is allowed.**
- See the financial secretary, Ms. Grant, in the front office to clear any financial obligations or you will not get a diploma after graduation (you will only receive a slip of paper that will direct you to pick up your diploma after you have met those obligations). **Deadline: June 3rd**
- Return your chromebook to Mr. Brenyo during 3rd block if you do not need it for exams. If you need your chromebook for exams, you can turn it in on your last exam day after exams have completed.

Rehearsal Information:

June 4, 2024 @ 5:30-7pm, Bojangles Coliseum

Arrive no later than 5pm

- **If you do not participate in the rehearsal, you do not walk for graduation.**
- Find your Junior Marshal with the sign that matches your notecard & last name. Then line up in order based on your notecard.
- Parking is available at Bojangles Coliseum.
- Do NOT bring anything with you to rehearsal. No food, drinks, water bottles, or book bags will be allowed in the arena. No one will be available to hold or keep anything for you.
- No guests – parents, family, or friends – are allowed in the arena on rehearsal day. Turn off cell phones and keep them in your pockets.

Graduation Information:
June 10, 2024 @ 7:00pm, Bojangles Coliseum
Arrive no later than 6:00pm

- Graduates need to be dressed in full regalia (cap, gown & tassel).
 - Dress code: Business attire – no jeans, tennis shoes, or shorts!
 - Men – Button down or collared shirt, dress pants, dress shoes
 - Women – Dress, skirt, or pants with formal business blouses or tops, dress shoes.
Please do not wear heels you cannot walk in.
 - No keys, phones, gum, purses, or backpacks. Leave these items with your family or guests. We are not responsible for your belongings – we ask that you not bring any item(s) that would have to be confiscated.
- Parking is available at Bojangles Coliseum.
- Find your Junior Marshal with the sign that matches your last name & notecard. Line up in order.
- Students should **not** decorate their regalia (if altered, you will not be allowed to walk).
- Students may only wear CMS approved graduation regalia. Any extra stoles, medallions etc will be confiscated.
- Students who choose to act inappropriately at any time during the ceremony will be removed from the ceremony and can pick up their diploma at school, after completing assigned community service hours.

Information for Family and Friends about Graduation:

- NO: flowers, backpacks, fanny packs, gifts, balloons, noisemakers, air horns, banners, packages, or outside food or beverage.
- Bag Policy: Any non-clear bags that do not exceed 4.5” x 6.5” in size, which is approximately the size of a handbag with or without a handle/strap, such as a small clutch purse. Clear bags that do not exceed 12” x 6” x 12”. Outside food and beverages are not permitted inside the venue. Prohibited Bags: Any non-clear bag larger than 4.5” x 6.5” and clear bags larger than 12” x 6” x 12” are not allowed.
- Everyone will go through a metal detector and all bags, including camera bags, will be searched.
- The coliseum will not hold items for your family and guests. If they choose to bring in a banned item, they will have to take it back to their vehicle.
- Parking is available at Bojangles Coliseum.
