## Things that have been Implemented:

- 1. OATECA Curriculum
- 2. EmpowerED Coaching Plan
- 3. Capturing Kids' Hearts Implementation began in August
- 4. Attendance: Efforts to support families and students with chronic absenteeism
- 5. SSPLC
  - Team meets regularly and collaborates with the EC department to address the needs of students requiring additional support.
- 6. **Admin Team Intake Meeting**: Ongoing efforts to support students and families during their transition to Metro School.
- 7. **Best Buddies Program**: Students participate in job skills training, resume building, and preparing for post-high school transitions.

  - Refers to updates in Title IX policies and guidelines established in 2020.
  - **Key Changes for 2024**: The 5-day review period has been switched back to a 10-day review period.
  - o 2020 Final Rule:
    - Supportive measures must be non-punitive and non-disciplinary.
    - Investigations must be concluded before any actions are taken.
  - Title IX Goals:
    - 1. Stop the behavior
    - 2. Prevent the recurrence
    - 3. Remedy the effects.

## **New Business**

Lakeishia Strong, EIT - OATECA Mid-Year Update: Mid Year Update

- Student Enrollment:
  - 61 students registered for the OATECA program.
  - Focus on targeted students in tested areas: Grades 3-5, Middle School, and High School.
- Facilitators:
  - Professional Development on data collection for facilitators.
  - DSC (Data Scoring Center) for analyzing student progress.
- Intervention Lab:
  - Designed with Flex Seating to accommodate diverse learning needs.
  - Hosted during academic enrichment time to provide additional support for students.
- Data Collection:
  - Teachers were provided blank **data sheets** to track student progress.
  - Student Requirements:
    - Complete 5 trials per objective.
    - Achieve at least **80% mastery** before moving on to the next objective.

- Facilitators input data into the **scoring report** for tracking.
- Progress Monitoring:
  - Students have completed 388 data entries.
  - o 11 students have mastered 15 academic skills so far.
- Mid-Year Reports:
  - o **2 reports** will be shared with parents, detailing:
    - Progress on each objective
    - Whether objectives are mastered or not
    - Time of day the skills were worked on
    - Focus on functional skills
- Celebrations:
  - Students who have mastered academic skills will be celebrated.
- Evidence of Mastery: A shared link was provided to access evidence of the student's progress.
