Graduation Date and Time

- When: June 12th, 2024
- What time: 7:30pm (Be to the Coliseum by 6:30pm)
- Where: Bojangles Coliseum
- Number of guests allowed: Unlimited

Graduation Rehearsal - **REQUIRED**

- When: June 6th
- Where: Bojangles Coliseum
- What time: 5:30-7:00 pm
- You do not need to wear your cap and gown to rehearsal, but need to follow CMS dress code
- Per CMS, you are required to attend rehearsal. **IF YOU DO NOT COME, YOU WILL NOT WALK AT GRADUATION**
- Ladies, if you plan on wearing heels to graduation, this is a good time to practice. We **HIGHLY RECOMMEND YOU DO NOT WEAR HEELS.**
- You will be standing for a long period of time before the graduation ceremony and ladies have tripped on the stairs/stage

Graduation Day Need to Know

- Graduating seniors should report to Bojangles' Coliseum no later than 6:30 PM on June 12th (one hour before the ceremony)
- All seniors must wear a cap and gown to participate in the graduation ceremony.
- All seniors, when robed in their cap and gown, must adhere to the following attire guidelines:
 - All gowns should be clean and neatly pressed with a cool iron or steamed. Be careful not to burn the gown, if you choose to iron it.
 - Young men must wear dark dress slacks, dress shirt, tie (optional) and dark closed-toe dress shoes.
 - Young ladies must wear dark dress slacks, a skirt or a dress with dark-closed-toe dress shoes; and the hemline of the skirt or dress should not fall below the hemline of the gown.
 - None of the following will be permitted:
 - Gold, silver, platinum or diamond encrusted fronts, sunglasses, headphones, iPods, Bluetooth earpieces, do-rags or head scarves, cell phones, cameras, purses, book bags, tote bags, noise making devices, beach balls, decorated caps, etc. Also, graduates who toss their caps as they walk through the graduation ceremony will not be allowed to come back to pick them up.
 - No jeans !!No Sneakers (no Jordans, no dunks,)
- Graduates will receive actual diplomas from home school representatives immediately following the ceremony.
- Rowdy or disruptive behavior will not be tolerated.

Fees

- If you owe fees, you **WILL NOT** be able to receive your diploma until fees are paid. Please see Your Counselor to find out if you owe any fees.
- All financial obligations must be satisfied by **May 31st**.
- *Chromebooks, chargers, hotspots, military uniforms, textbooks, library books, etc. must all be returned – no exceptions*

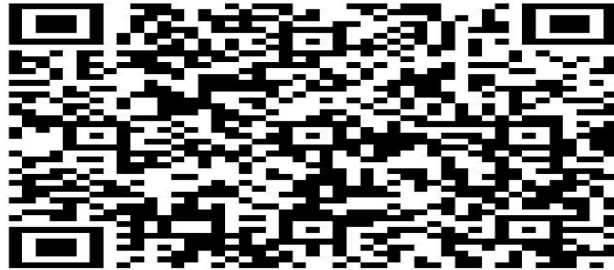
