In an effort to extend our students' learning at home, we want to make sure you are well informed about an online learning platform in which your child is enrolled. This platform contains virtual lessons taught by highly qualified certified teachers who teach the lessons through videos and engaging activities.

- The lessons are aligned to NC standards.
- The lessons are similar to online courses provided by colleges and universities.

Teachers and administrators will be tracking and monitoring student progress. Students will be graded based on their scores on activities, quizzes, and assessments in the platform.

- Grades are weighted the same as in PowerSchool.
- Grades from the online course work will be reflected in PowerSchool.

STEP 1

Go to learn.edgenuity.com/student

Login to Edgenuity

→ Username: cmsIDnumber
(Ex: cms12345678)

→ Password: IDnumber
(Ex: 12345678)

STEP 2

→ On the Edgenuity Home Page, an Orientation Video will appear in the middle. You must watch this 2 minute video before you can select any course.

→ After you watch the video, close it and choose an icon for any course in which you are enrolled:

- ◆ GVSA Your Grade Math Power Lessons
- ◆ GVSA Your Grade ELA Power Lessons
- ◆ GVSA Your Grade Science Power Lessons
- ◆ GVSA Your Grade Social Studies Power Lessons
- ◆ GVSA Your Grade Elective Name
 - Example: GVSA 7th Grade CSDII

STEP 3

→ In the Course Map, an Orientation Video will appear in the middle. You must watch this 4 minute video before you can begin any work.

→ After you watch the video, close it and click the first assignment/test link.

STEP 4

You may track your progress in Edgenuity through the Student Progress Report.

→ Course Completed Percentage: Percentage of the course completion

→ Color-coded Completion Squares: Colored indicators for falling behind, on track, and being ahead

→ Overall Grade: Percentage represents the grade for completed activities but does not take into account how far you are in the course
