#### Welcome

Meeting began at 1:00 pm via MS Teams. Principal Steve Drye welcomed all attendees and reviewed the minutes from the 30 May 2024 SIP meeting. Minutes were approved unanimously.

## **SIP Annual Review and Meetings**

Principal Drye provided a comprehensive Annual Review of school performance vs. indicators encompassing relevant data; successes; challenges; and opportunities.

#### **Proposed 2024-25 Teacher Workdays**

- Principal Drye shared a <u>draft</u> workdays document for review and input by the SIT with new CMS Crown Academy Onboarding Experience 2024 parameters considered.
- Maximum optional workdays were included in support of this new initiative per CMS directives.

## Staffing 2024- 2025

- Principal Drye discussed current vacancies as follows:
  - o EC Assistant / PNA 2024 -25 and an EC Assistant Extensions have been hired!
  - Math / Science Teacher 7 has been upgraded to an MCL (SE) position to provide additional leadership and coaching as well as teaching.
  - Math Teacher 6
- He also discussed possible position exchanges for guest teachers if no suitable math candidates could be located by August.

# **Title IX Review**

- Principal Drye provided a review of the Title IX process and current reporting.
- He solicited input from parents concerning additional:
  - Recommendations for preventing sexual harassment in and ensuring that students understand their right to be protected from sexual harassment; and
  - Strategies for ensuring students understand how to report possible sexual harassment and are aware of the school's obligation to promptly and effectively respond to sexual harassment complaints.
- Previous suggestions were reviewed:
  - Reiterating / reinforcing these topics at grade level assemblies;
  - Following up with feeder elementary schools to determine any gaps for rising 6th graders;
  - Posting additional student-friendly signage to inform students of multiple ways to report potential Title IX violations (i.e., SS-ARS / Say Something App; Google Form on Launchpad);
  - Providing a Launchpad tour via CCTV announcements; and
  - Acquiring TVs to scroll key messages in high traffic locations throughout the school.
- Principal Drye noted that these topics were shared with students in second semester grade level assemblies and that
  Title IX is reported most frequently in person to a trusted adult although some cases have been reported via the
  SS-ARS app.
- It is evident that students 1) understand Title IX; and 2) know how to use various modalities to report concerns.

• Principal Drye noted that Title IX incidents at MHMS continue to decline and he attributed this to ongoing efforts to educate students.
