## UNIVERSITY PARK CREATIVE ARTS ELEMENTARY SCHOOL PARENT AND FAMILY ENGAGEMENT POLICY

The University Park Creative Arts Elementary Schools' Title I program encourages each parent to be involved in their child's education. This policy outlines the parent involvement activities that will be conducted during the school year:

- Open House/Back-to-School/Meet the Teacher Night was held on August 22, 2024, including teacher-led class meetings. Community partners will host tables to market and recruit volunteers.
- Our Title I General PTA Meeting will be held on September 26, 2024. This will include Parent Welcome/Engagement and Curriculum Night. This meeting will cover the following information and give parents the opportunity to provide input into the Title I school-wide program.

- Monthly newsletters, suggestions on how to work with your child, suggested books to read with your child, as well as other information will be sent home periodically to parents to help their children succeed in school.
- Parent-teacher conferences will be scheduled in October and November 2024. Teachers will be available to review your child's progress and answer questions.
- An annual review is held each spring to review the Title I school-wide program. Parents are welcome to attend. The results from the annual spring review as well as teacher input will be considered when planning for the next year. The results of this annual review from the spring of 2024 will be shared with parents at the annual parent meeting in the fall.
