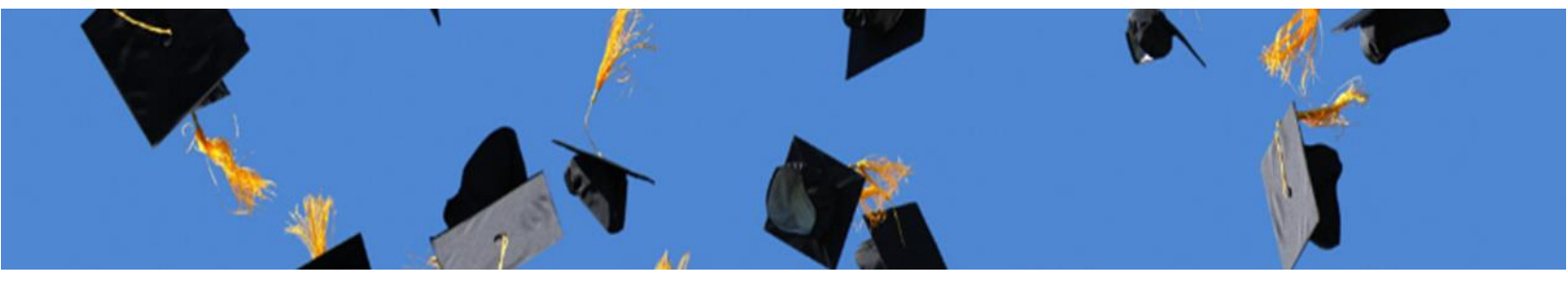
Important Graduation Information

- There are no seating limits or tickets to attend graduation this year. Bring your family!!
- The ceremony will be live streamed and the link will be provided prior to the ceremony.
- Bojangles Coliseum will open at 7:30 AM for guests to find seating.
- Do not bring any flowers, balloons, noisemakers, or any potential item that could be a distraction. They will make you dispose of these items at the door.
- Do not bring backpacks, fanny packs, gifts, or outside food and beverage.
- All bags will be searched prior to entry.
- All people, guests and grads alike, entering the arena will be scanned by security.
- CMS is hiring a photographer to snap a picture of your student as they come across the stage. Info will be provided to purchase this picture.
- Students need to be "hands-free" during the ceremony so that means NO PHONES or KEYS or PURSES, etc. They will be taken from you upon entry.

Cap and Gown Information

What is Credit Recovery?

Students can take up to 4 credit recovery courses for the summer for a course previously failed on Edgenuity.

Students that need additional credits to be promoted to the next grade can earn up to 2 credits of new coursework (not including EOC courses).

*Summer credit recovery is not for students to get ahead. 😊

- Students will be required to check in with their Credit Recovery teacher biweekly.

STEM Prep

Preparing Students for College-Level STEM Courses

Supported by generous funding from Honeywell, STEM Prep is an academic enrichment program for under-represented minority (URM) current high school rising 11th graders, rising 12th graders and graduating 12th graders who are interested in pursuing associate degrees in health sciences, information technology or engineering disciplines. This 4-week, summer program will be held in-person. Participants will enroll in non-credit courses that provide them with project-based experiences. Upon completion, participants of STEM Prep will:

- Gain increased familiarity with current practices in STEM fields
- Illustrate preparedness for a successful transition into STEM studies at the college level
- Participate in a coordinated exploration of careers in their targeted STEM focus area

All STEM Prep students will receive a personalized math enrichment plan that is designed to prepare them for college-level mathematics and will participate in lab-based activities in their choice of science, technology or engineering content areas.
