Classroom List Day

Selwyn Elementary has a tradition of posting each child's assigned teacher during what is known as "List Night." Class lists will be posted online only on Selwyn Elementary School's website at 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, August 21, 2024. Please note that all class assignments are temporary, pending an increase or decrease in enrollment as calculated on the twentieth day of school. This is a state procedure and our teacher allotments are funded by the state based upon enrollment. Any changes in class assignments will be communicated to parents prior to changes taking place.

School Supplies

You may bring your child's school supplies on "Meet the Teacher" and leave them with the teacher. If your child will be riding the bus on the first day of school, I encourage you to bring their supplies so they can ride comfortably and bring any remaining supplies in as they are able. If you purchased supplies through the PTA, your child's teacher will have information as to how they will be distributed.

Transferring Families Meeting and "Meet the Teacher"

"Meet the Teacher" will take place on Thursday, August 22, 2024. During "Meet the Teacher," your child will meet the teacher and visit the classroom. Transferring families will meet from 12:00 - 12:30 in the Media Center. The following is the schedule:

First Day of School

The first day of school for students is Monday, August 26, 2024. Our school day will begin at 7:45 a.m. and will end at 2:45 p.m. Morning car rider drop-off is available between 7:15 and 7:45 a.m. If you arrive after 7:45 a.m., you will be required to park, walk your child/children to the front office, and sign your child/children in with our front office staff. For that reason, I strongly encourage all families to utilize our bus transportation and/or create a carpool system with other families as we expect major traffic issues and congestion during the first few weeks of school.

Kindergarten Information

The Kindergarten team and I are so excited to welcome our new Selwyn Eagles! Parents will receive a phone call from their child's Kindergarten teacher on Monday, August 19 or Tuesday, August 20 no later than 5:00 PM. The Kindergarten teacher will introduce herself and will notify parents of their child's staggered entry day. The Kindergarten school tour, which is optional for parents, will take place on Thursday, August 22 from 10:00 - 10:30. Immediately following the tour our Kindergarten students and parents will meet the teacher 10:30 - 11:30. Students will enjoy popsicles on the playground afterwards from 11:30 - 12:00.

Kindergarten attendance is staggered the first four days of school. Kindergarteners will only attend <u>one</u> of the first four days of school (August 26 - August 29, 2024). All Kindergarteners will report to school on Friday, August 30, 2024. Please call the school at 980-343-5835 if you have any questions.

Bus Assignment

Important update regarding bus assignments for the 2024-2025 school year. CMS Transportation will no longer print and send home bus labels to CMS families. Beginning August 19, parents will be able to access bus stop information digitally through the "Here Comes the Bus" app, "AlphaRoute," or by calling CMS Transportation at 980-343-6715.

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First Day Folders

A packet of information will be sent home with every child on the first day of school with very important forms. Please go through this entire packet and return all of the forms to your child's teacher no later than Friday, August 30, 2024. Kindergarten students will bring home their packets on their first full day of school, August 30, 2024. All Kindergarten students are to return their forms to their teacher no later than Friday, September 6, 2024.
