Responsibility #1: Work in conjunction with CMS leadership to plan, implement and monitor compliance with CMS Policy JL – Student Wellness and other CMS policies, regulations, and programs related to health and wellness.

Responsibility #2: Review CMS annual progress report related to compliance with Policy JL.

Responsibility #3: Develop resources for staff, students, and parents about CMS health policies and regulations that impact student mental and physical health.

Responsibility #4: Promote student-centered programs intended to positively impact health, wellness and safety.

AED boxes are being delivered to the schools.</li> <li>● Immunization reminders over the summer: Messaging will go out regarding immunizations. Communications will use various platforms to inform families about the recommended immunizations.</li> <li>● HAC Attestations-Principals are to complete the Healthy Active Children attestation form by September in order for their school to be in compliance with the NC State Board of Education’s Healthy Active Children Policy.</li> <li>● SBVC-Atrium has added additional schools. At this time, we are still waiting to see the capacity to continue to grow in the Fall.</li> </ul>
