

SCHOOL BUS SAFETY FOCUS | DECEMBER

Team, as we enter December, let's turn our attention to a crucial safety check covering three key areas: **Defrost, Decals, and Dimmer Switch**.

Here's the breakdown:

- 1. **Defrost**: Ensure those defrost systems are in top-notch condition. To check, place a piece of paper over the vent and make sure the air is flowing through smoothly. I want everyone to navigate through winter fog and frost with clear visibility.
- 2. **Decals**: Give those decals a once-over. Let's keep things tidy, ensuring all essential information is easily visible. If you spot any tears, rips, or missing decals, please notify your area manager so we can promptly replace them.
- 3. **Dimmer Switch**: Take a moment to check the dimmer switch. Proper lighting is so important for your safety and that of our students. Confirm that the blue light illuminates on your dashboard and that your lights function properly.
