

- Acceptable attendance



### **Employment Term/Salary (Driving)**

#### **Bus Driver**

Transport students for assigned programs.

#### **Bus Monitor**

Monitor and assist students on bus.


#### **Child Nutrition Worker**

CDL required. Ability to lift 40 lbs. repeatedly, drive refrigerated truck load and unload, clean and refuel truck (other duties as assigned).

### **ASEP Summer Camp**

Current CDL drivers. Assist with field trips and TA duties.

All driving positions require valid CDL. All applicants must currently be employed as a driver or monitor and meet the applicant requirements. Dates, times and hours may vary based on need.






### **Employment Term/Salary (Non-Driving)**
