
**Bus Driver** *Transport students for assigned programs.*

All driving positions require valid CDL. All applicants must currently be employed as a driver or monitor and meet the applicant requirements. Dates, times and hours may vary based on need.






## **Employment Term/Salary (Non-Driving)**

#### **Transportation Garage**

Interior/Exterior Cleaning, wheel prep, seat repairs, and bus transport, and parts room.

All driving positions require valid CDL. All applicants must currently be employed as a driver or monitor and meet the applicant requirements. Dates, times and hours may vary based on need.





As our department continues to grow and expand, we are constantly seeking new opportunities to maximize our mission and vision! Our commitment to serving the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Schools community remains unwavering, and we are excited to announce new job openings that reflect our growth. Openings include:

- <u>Bus Driver</u> | Responsible for driving a school bus to provide safe, efficient, and on-time transportation of CMS students to and from assigned schools on a daily basis.
- <u>Technician I</u> | Responsible for performing routine preventative maintenance on vehicular equipment including gasoline and diesel-driven vehicles to maintain a safe economical fleet.
- Technician II | Performs complex duties in the operation, repair and maintenance of buses and other vehicles in the school transportation program. Most work is performed based on prior experience. The employee is expected to troubleshoot and resolve problems of varied complexity and difficulty with little assistance. Significant problems may be referred to a supervisor. Most errors are expected to be resolved by the employee. The employee receives general supervision and work is occasionally reviewed while in progress.
- <u>Director, Fleet</u> | The Director of Fleet Services provides leadership in managing, directing, and coordinating safe, efficient, and economical maintenance of school buses, activity buses and fleet vehicles. This position is responsible for ensuring total compliance with all aspects of legal, financial, preventive maintenance and safety regulations relating to the maintenance and repair of school buses and transportation fleet vehicles.
- <u>Manager, Transportation Support</u> | To manage, direct, and coordinate the activities of the budgeting function in the transportation area; to coordinate budgeting activities with other divisions and departments; and to provide highly complex staff assistance to the Executive Director of Transportation.
- <u>Lead Bus Driver</u> | Responsible for the coordination and monitoring of fifteen to twenty bus drivers and school buses, to include: receiving instructions and guidance as well as relaying critical information concerning driver and equipment status.
