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## **HERITAGE**

Cato Middle College High School (CMCHS) opened in 2007 and was Charlotte-Mecklenburg Schools' first Middle College program. CMCHS is a Cooperative Innovative High School located on the Cato Campus of Central Piedmont Community College (CPCC) and is part of the Career and College Promise program. It is an honors program that consists of grades 11-13.

## GENERAL ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Rising 11th or 12 grader\*
- Resident of Mecklenburg County
- Current unweighted GPA of 2.8 OR 2.5 unweighted GPA with qualifying test scores
- Completed selected courses by the end of 10th grade:
  Math I or Algebra I, Math II or Geometry, Biology I, English I, English II, World
  History, a founding principles course (Civics and Economics, Civic Literacy, or AP
  Government and Politics), and Health/PE, and passed English III and Math III
  (rising seniors)

\*If you do not currently attend a CMS school, you must have completed the New Student Enrollment process and have been assigned a CMS Student ID number and CMS PIN number

### BENEFITS

- Enrollment limited to 100 students per grade level
- All high school courses are Honors or Advanced Placement
- Students can earn an Associate's Degree or transferable college credit

- College credits transfer to all UNC system colleges
