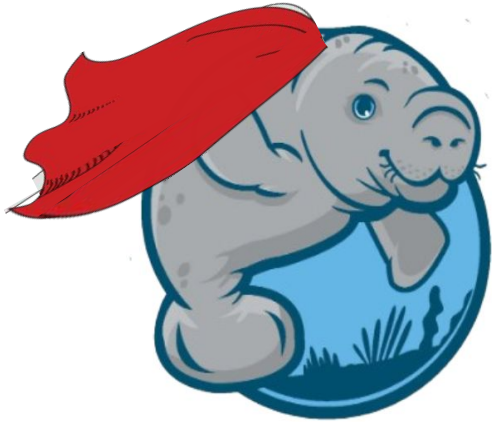

# Attendance Terms

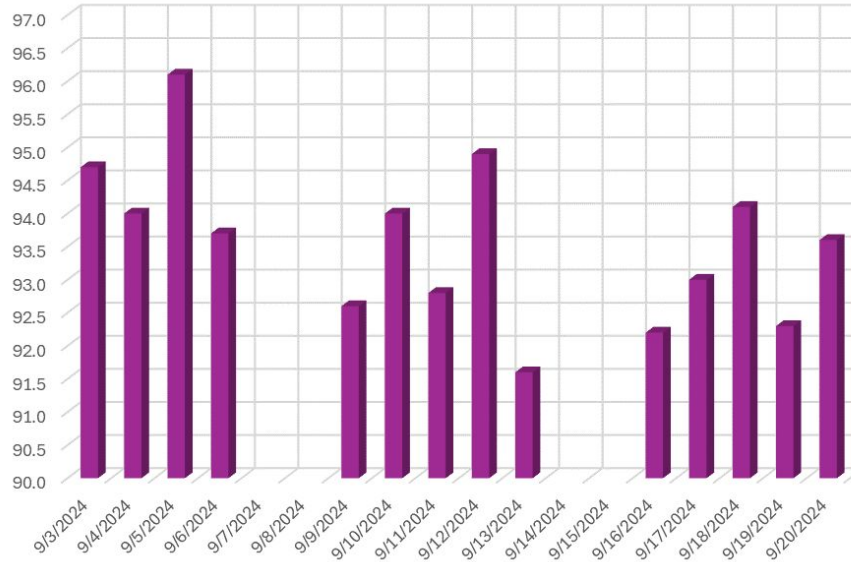
**Chronic absenteeism** =  
missing over 10% of school  
due to  
absences for any reason  
(excused, unexcused absences  
and suspensions)

missing over 10 days of school  
due to  
unexcused absences

# UNEXCUSED

Absences for reasons listed below are **EXCUSED**:

- a. Illness or injury of the student
- b. Death in the immediate family
- c. Quarantine
- d. Medical/Dental appointments
- e. Religious observances
- f. Educational opportunity
- g. Local school board policy
- h. Child care (for student's child)
- i. Absence related to deployment activities
- j. Court or administrative proceeding

Absences for reasons listed below are **UNEXCUSED**:

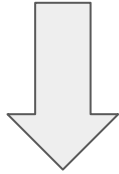
- a. Bad weather
- b. Missing the bus
- c. Car trouble
- d. Oversleeping
- e. Lack of heat, water or electricity
- f. Shopping
- g. Baby sitting
- h. Lack of clothing or shoes



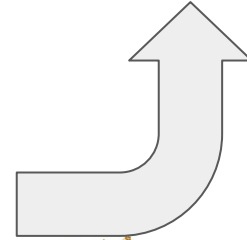




By 6th grade, chronic absence becomes a leading indicator that a student will **drop out** of high school.

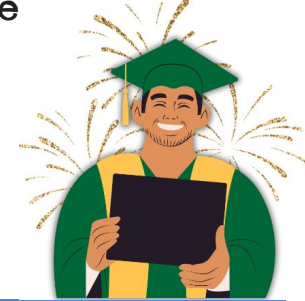
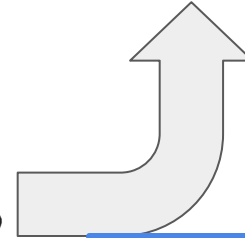


Poor attendance can influence whether children read proficiently by the end of 3rd grade or be **held back**.



Absenteeism in the first month of school can predict poor attendance throughout the school year.

Half the students who miss 2-4 days in September go on to **MISS NEARLY A MONTH** of school.



**BUT**, when students' attendance rates improve so do their chances for graduating

# Grading Policy (Grades 3-5 Only)

## Mint Hill Elementary Grading

**24-25**

### Prepare

**0%**

Assignments that allow students to practice new learning with no risk for mistakes

Assignments with heavy teacher scaffolding and reliance on peers for completion should be used to provide students with daily feedback

### Rehearse

**40%**

Assignments that provide feedback of students' progress leading up to demonstrating/assessing mastery of a standard(s)

Reading: 8 min/ 10 max  
Math: 8 min/ 10 max  
Science: 2 min/ 4 max  
Social Studies 2 min/ 4 max

### Perform

**60%**

Culminating/formative assessments that measure mastery of one or more standards

Reading: 2 min/ 3 max  
Math: 2 min/ 3 max  
Science: 1 min/ 2 max  
Social Studies: 1 min/ 2 max



# Report Cards & Progress Reports

## Progress Reports

Sent Home approximately 5 weeks into each quarter; families sign and return

## Report Cards

Sent home at the end of each quarter; families keep the report card but send back the envelope/form signed to teacher
