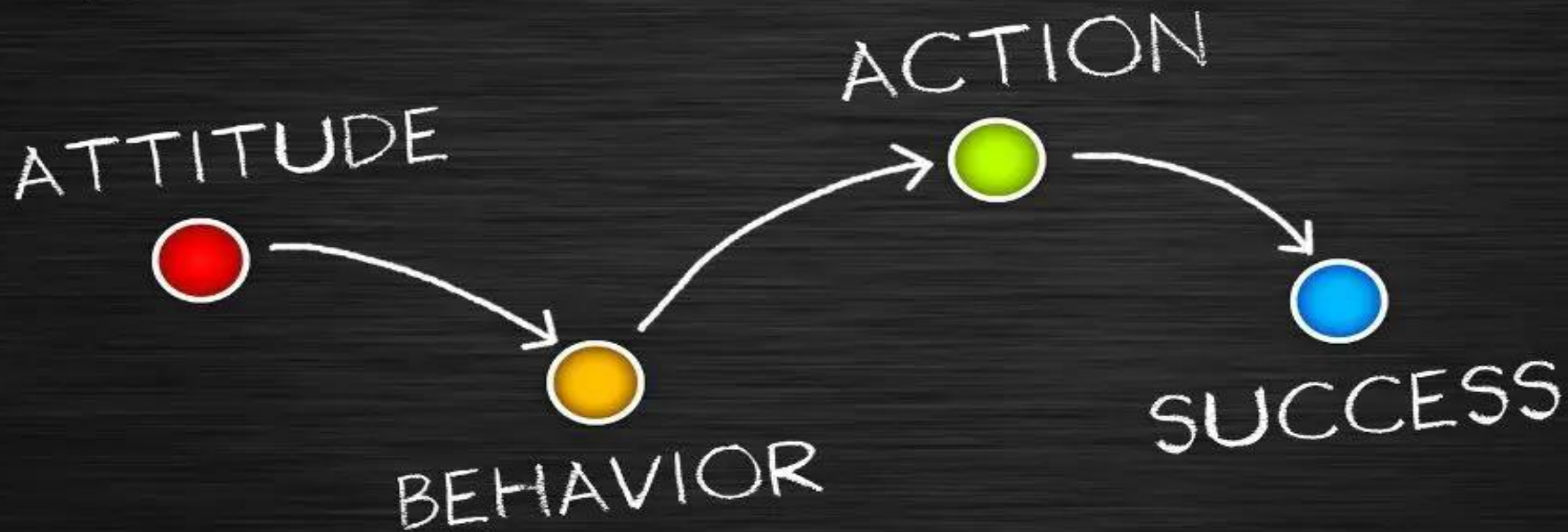

Budget

What is a Title I school?

Title I is the largest federally funded educational program. A Title I school is a school receiving federal funds for students. The basic principle of Title I is that schools with large concentrations of low-income students receive supplemental funds to meet students' educational goals.

How is Title 1 funding used at ARMS?

- Beginning Teacher Support Coordinator
- Parent Involvement
- Professional Development for staff
- Stipends for high performing teachers
- Additional Teachers (Math & Spanish)
- Supplies and materials (instructional technology, digital platforms)
- Behavior support
