What is Title I?



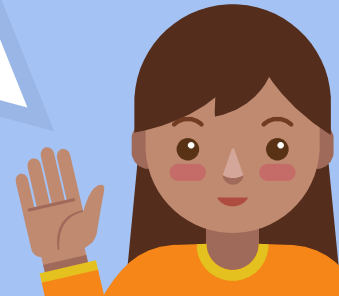
What is Title I?

- ❑ Parent communication about student performance

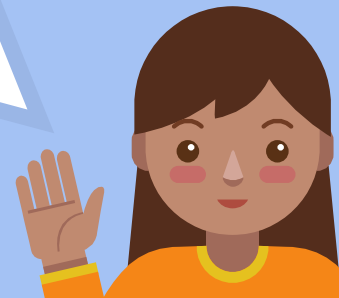

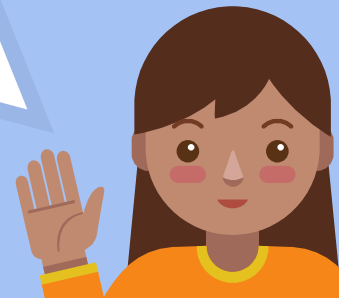


Our Goals

- ❑ 3-5 Composite: **29.4% to 34.4%**

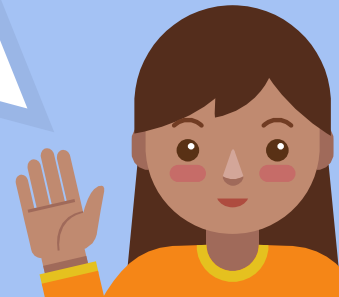

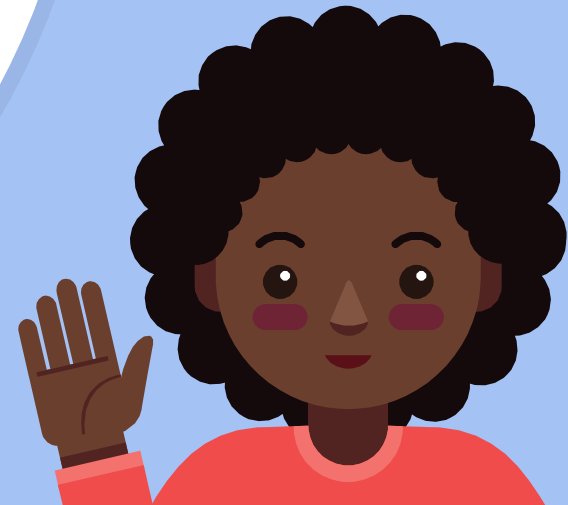

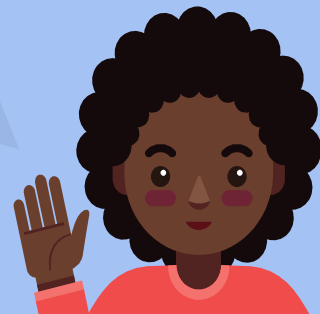

- ☐ Parents engaging with ParentSquare app from 15% to 30%

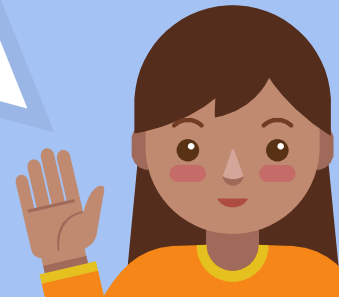
