Why houses?

Being a member of a house is being a member of a family. Houses offer comradery, collaboration, communication, and connection. We will have House meetings, House celebrations, and team building activities that will foster a sense of community!

How does the house system work?

Throughout the year, the House members gain individual points for behavior and academic success. Houses will gain points and leading houses will receive various rewards for the highest points earned throughout the year.

Why are we doing this?

We want our students to be motivated to come to school, be inspired to achieve their goals, and have a sense of family and community at ROA.

We also want our students to achieve high self-esteem, confidence, and life skills.

How do students get in a house?

We will have a house sorting celebration for each grade level. Current 5th graders have a house.

New 5th graders and all other students will have their sorting day. Every child will be randomly sorted into one of the four houses. Each house will be represented in each classroom. See dates below.

House Points

Standard Points (1-2): following expectations, attendance, uniform, respectful, effort, answering questions with evidence

Above & Beyond Points (3-5): working extremely hard, meeting growth goals, improving social/academic behavior, helping a student in need, displaying character trait of the month, attending school functions, 80% or higher on an assessment

Special Points (6): No referral/minor incidents for quarter, perfect score on assessment

Ultra Points (10-25): Perfect attendance, A/B honor roll, A honor roll, outstanding achievement, academic excellence
