- IV. Principal Report Becky Crawford
 - a.) Welcome back from Winter Break/December Celebrations fun filled Decemberb.) Mid-Year Testing -
 - This week taking MVPA (cumulative assessment to help us identify gaps in standards that had been taught). Conducting makeup testing now.
 - Next week is the iReady assessment (tests students in a more adaptive way based on how students perform). After iReady assessments, students are assigned lessons based on their performance.
 - Ongoing Dibels is a K-3 assessment focusing on phonics, fluency and comprehension.
 - Goal is to have all assessments completed by teacher workday on 1/24.
- **c.)** Comprehensive Plan Updates CMS posted a video to PTA Facebook of the bulldozer tearing down the building; our understanding is once the field is cleared then it should take about 9 months to complete the build. Dennis says we are on target with the schedule.
 - d.) School Updates/Safety Assessment -
 - <u>Staffing</u>: New front end secretary, Kathy Hilderbrand, from Cabarrus County. She has a lot of experience with our different programs and has jumped right in and learned a lot.
 - <u>Enrollment</u>: We have enrolled about 12 new students and several are from the international center; these students have an additional step of a language screening when they enroll.
 - <u>Safety Assessment</u> the cement balls now have a cement platform and additional ones have been added - this was based on Safety audit feedback; the lattice is on the trailers

- **g.) Title IX** We have not had anyTitle IX incidents this year. We continue to encourage students to treat each other appropriately and respectfully.
