End of Year Update/Testing - Still wrapping up our end of year (before EOGs) testing; projections are on point but it is very close to the border between an A and a B; really focusing on the standards that students need; we understand it is a lot of testing, but the data we receive is very impactful; 16 days until EOGs begin; we can reteach and retest before the school year ends; Retest opportunities: 3rd Math; 4th Reading and Math; 5th Reading and Math retests - these scores do not count towards growth but they do count toward proficiency
