I. Parent and Family Engagement Policy

II. Annual Information Meeting

The meeting provided parents an opportunity to learn about the K-5th grade curriculum as well as informing them what it means to be a Title I school.

IV. Title I Part A Planning

Communication with parents is crucial for student academic success. Berewick uses a variety of methods to communicate with parents and school community such as: ParentSquare, Facebook, Instagram, ConnectEd phone calls and text messages, Parent/Teacher conferences, Open House and other online platforms such as Class Dojo.

V. Parent Information and Opportunities

Title I: We have our Title I status posted on the school website and we shared the information at the Title I Parent Meeting on 9/21/23.

School Profile: Berewick has our school profile posted on our website.

Child’s Performance: Fall Parent/Teacher conferences will be scheduled at the end of the 1st Quarter. Teachers will review student progress and answer any questions parents may have. Parents may schedule additional conferences as needed anytime throughout the school year. Also, teachers share information about student performances on a frequent basis. Teachers will complete grades on a timely basis and parents will have access to this information via PowerSchool. The school will send out information on how to access the PowerSchool grade book in September.

Curriculum: Berewick Elementary held their curriculum night on 9/21/23. Each grade level presented an outline of their curriculum for the year, and these presentations were recorded. The presentations will be available on the school website all year. Grade levels also send weekly newsletters letting parents and guardians know what will be taught for the upcoming week.

Regular Meetings for Decision Making: The first meeting of SIT will be held 9/26/23. This team is charged with drafting the annual School Improvement Plan. In addition, all parents are encouraged to participate in our School Leadership Team meetings where we will discuss the School Improvement Plan and track progress towards our goals.

Access to Staff and Volunteer Opportunities: Parents can contact teachers and other staff members via email and ParentSquare. Staff members will ensure that they respond to the parent/guardian within 24 hours. Teachers asked parents their preferred method of communication at Open House and do communicate using the chosen method whether it is email, text, ParentSquare or Class Dojo. The staff at Berewick work hard to ensure parents have access to them and encourage parents to communicate on a frequent basis.
